

TAG REINFORCEMENT, SPECIAL SHAPE AND ATTACHMENT INFORMATION SHEET



Reinforcement options.

The paper washer is used on card and non tare tyvek. It is attached when we punch the hole and gives better reinforcement than just having a brass eyelet on its own. However it does not look as neat as a brass eyelet. Brass eyelets are used on Art card and tough tag. We also use them when a neater finish is required. Finally on many smaller tags we just drill a hole.

Attachment options

The standard size string and wire is 10" flat which gives either 2 x 5" lengths. With elastic and cotton a full loop is formed with 4" knot to hole as the standard length. Many other finer, thicker or braided cords are available which have to be attached by hand.

Special shape options.

Cut corners at the head of the tag are standard for all tags over 70 x 35 mm (size 1). 3mm round corners are available with out the need for a cutter on all tags above size 1. However they are neater and more precise if cut out with a cutting form. Small square cut tags (commonly called swing tickets) only require a cutter if they are very small. All other small swing tickets and shapes have to be die cut at extra cost. We have many cutter shapes available.
